DANCE ATTIRE & SHOES

Your dancer **MUST** be in proper uniform for all dance classes. **PINK** girls are required to wear black bodysuit and pink tights. **BLUE, GREEN & ORANGE** are required to wear a black bodysuit, black shorts or leggings. No baggy clothing can be worn as the teachers need to see the body lines of the dancers. The boy's uniform is black or blue track pants with a plain t-shirt.

You will also need proper dance shoes as street shoes are not acceptable. If you are unsure of the dance shoes your child needs – please talk to Miss Cori or your teachers. Your hair should be pulled neatly back in a bun for **ALL** Ballet classes and a ponytail for all other classes.

All Hip Hop students can be in comfortable clothing; jeans or skirts are not permitted.

All dancewear and shoes are available at the studio or from your local dance shop. Please **DO NOT WEAR YOUR DANCE SHOES OUTSIDE!!!**
